

WVU EXTENSION ACTIVE CALENDAR – A USEFUL TOOL

/SUMMARY

Reach more people and manage events better using the WVU Extension Active Calendar.

/BACKGROUND

West Virginia University uses Active Calendar (https://calendar.wvu.edu) for publishing events on websites and information stations. The WVU Extension Service also uses it for publishing events via the web, social media and email.

Each WVU Extension Service county office is provided with one administrative account and to use Active Calendar for posting Extension event information. Any employee or student with an active WVU Login/Password can submit events for approval. Publish your event online at your website and share it with others beyond WVU.

/FEATURES

Active Calendar has a number of great features that make it very easy and usable including:

- A simple, one-page web-based form with a few required fields and many optional fields.
- A point-and-click, what-you-see-is-what-you-get (WYSIWYG) events editor.
- An importer to find relevant events on other calendars and add those without editing.
- An event registration system to set attendee limits, waitlists and notices of event changes.
- Grid, summary and list views of events fully searchable by keyword and filterable by category.
- Saving events to Outlook and other clients and sharing events via social media and email.

/COSTS

- Free. One (1) Active Calendar administrator account provided per county.
- Any employee or student with a current and valid WVU Login/Password can submit events.

/PROCESS

- 1. Visit the WVU Extension Active Calendar (<u>https://calendar.wvu.edu/site/wvuextension</u>).
- 2. 'Sign In' at the top of the screen by using your current and valid WVU Login/Password.
- 3. Add all required and as much helpful information that doesn't need maintained about the event.
- 4. Tag as many relevant keywords as well as WVU Extension calendar categories for publishing.
- 5. Don't upload documents, rather link to them from an Extension website for easy maintenance.

Alternatively, to add events to an Extension County Office or the Jackson's Mill calendar:

- A. Visit the Calendar Directory (<u>https://calendar.wvu.edu/directory</u>) and find the link for the county site or WVU Jackson's Mill. **Tip:** use the search box to find a county or WVU Jackson's Mill.
- B. Use the 'Visit Site' link to access the calendar you want to which you want to submit an event.
- C. 'Sign In' at the top of the screen by using your current and valid WVU Login/Password.

- Event registration system doesn't accept payments, but it can be linked to a payment site.
